

I would like to thank everyone who had a hand, no matter how large or small, in the running of our Summer Coronation. You did an amazing job, and nobody left wanting for a thing, except for things they lost and others found.

Just now looking over my notes from Caloncon there was a lot of information to process, not only in the Seneschal's meeting but I am guessing in all the officer's meetings. I hope those that attended enjoyed their time getting to know their fellow officers from around the kingdom, their Kingdom level bosses and also came away with lots of ideas, and new processes that are for some, already in the works.

For me it was a dozen pages of notes to go over and pass along to everyone. Bullet points for everyone!

- Marshalls should be reporting youth fighting activities, if the barony has any. We did have some at coronation so please make a note of that.
- Officers, please make sure your memberships are up to date, double check those blue cards because those dates can sneak up on you.

- O If you are not sure, please check with your Kingdom level boss and also, read your handbook!

There is more, and if anyone would like to know or see what was talked about please let me know and I will share my handout with you.

One of the biggest item that came out of the meeting was more on the social media side concerning the creation of Facebook event pages. "No social media site/outlet may publish content unless that content has already been published in the required SCA venue first. The following are the most common types of information applicable under this section and is not meant to be exhaustive; in all cases, verify the requirements for publication in the relevant policy.Initial event publication in a Kingdom Newsletter/Kingdom Website for official status;..."

Meaning, that a Facebook event page CAN NOT be created until the flyer has been printed in The Mews. With this change I would like all future event stewards to think about getting their flyer created ASAP! This will help with getting the facebook event page up sooner rather than later. Please if you are hosting an event, think about getting a flyer out with at least the basic requirements for a flyer, all info can be found on the last page of The Mews or by contacting the Kingdom Chronicler at chronicler@calontir.org . Flyers can always be updated for future Mews issues.

I have set up a now working Gmail account for the Seneschal. If you have a question concerning anything in the barony please now contact me at blt.seneschal@gmail.com I will be using that email from now on as to have a place to track all issues and official business. I am doing this because when I step down I would like my successor to have access to this and have a history of what is happening.

Finally the reminders about bids. Bids for October 2019 Crown are due to the Barony by the August 20th business meeting. If you are interested, please think about putting in a bid. And, as always we are in the need of a bid for 12 th Night 2019. If you would like to Event Steward either of these events, or know of a site that the barony can use please let me know. From the Chancellor of the Exchequer

Greetings to the populace of the Lonely Tower.

There have been many changes to Society and Kingdom financial policy and procedures and more to come. Some policies aren't changing, rather they are going to be more strictly enforced. The following is not all-inclusive:

- -Gate forms will be changed to reflect only persons present, membership status, and funds received.
- -Minors and Adults will be tallied on the same forms.
- -Waivers will be handled by the Seneschal.
- -No one may sign anyone else in at an event...with the exception of minors, let's be realistic.
- -Funds received for Feast will be recorded on a separate form.
- -Funds for Gate, Inn, Feast, and any fundraising will be kept totally separate.
- -Baronages are considered a type of Royalty by Society and therefore Influencers--they will be immediately removed from all financial accounts.
- -Epay is required for Crown Tourney, Coronation, Queen's Prize, Kingdom A&S, King's Company of Archers, and Lilies. The requirement can be handled by either offering ePay pre-registration or ePay at the door. Both are not required.
- -If a group wishes to use ePay at any other event, a request from must be sent to Kingdom 60 days prior.
- -Events can be labeled Free, Donation, or Site Fee. If an event is Free, no donations shall be requested; Donations may be requested but not suggested—if a donation is suggested then it becomes a Site Fee; all Sites with a Fee will have an NMR fee added.

- -Cash Advances cannot be deposited into a member's account--they must be cashed; and all unused cash returned to the exchequer the day of the event along with all receipts and the tally form that accompanies the Cash Advance form.
- -Receipts submitted for reimbursement shall only have reimbursable items on it--nothing else.
- -Site Fee "comps" at an event: required are King, Queen, Prince, and Princess. If a group decides to comp more, that is up to their discretion--the numbers shall be forwarded to the Chamberlain prior to the event. All other can be handled locally through financial policy.
- -"Comps" for feast are required only for the big 4...if a group decides to comp more, that is up to their discretion--the numbers shall be forwarded to the Chamberlain prior to the event. Note: the number of people at "head table" is the privileged decision of TRM. While it may require some shuffling if TRM decide to have 12 people at head table rather than the 8 the cooks and hall steward planned, that is their prerogative.
- -Originals of all event waivers will be sent to the NMR Deputy within 14 days of the event. -Failure to comply will result in suspension of the group.
- -NMR fees to Kingdom within 10 days of the event.
- -Event Reports to Kingdom within 30 days of the event.
- -Groups must have a local financial policy that will include money handling during multi-day events, refunds for pre-registration, and "comps" for site.
- -All groups will submit an annual budget at the end of October.

There will be more as the policies are finalized and procedures established.

From the Anser Pursuivant

I received quite the surprise at the recent celebration of Their Royal Majesties Coronation. During evening court, Meisterin Brigida von München, Gold Falcon Principal Herald announced that she had granted me elevation to the rank of Herald Extraordinary. To say that I was honored and delighted would be a huge understatement. Even as the scroll was being read in court, I knew that this month's heraldry article should probably explain just what it was I was receiving. It just is not something that is well known outside heraldic circles.

Herald Extraordinary is a rank bestowed upon a herald to recognize their lengthy and/or exceptional service as a herald. It is an exception to the norms of our Society, in that it is one of the few awards given not by the crown. Instead, it is bestowed by the Kingdom's Principal Herald on behalf of the Kingdom's College of Heralds (Or by the Laurel Sovereign on behalf of the Society College of Arms.). It is based on a rank within the British College of Arms, and was first instituted in the Society during the tenure of Wilhelm Laurel.

A little known facet to heraldry that non-heralds usually pay no attention to, is the existence of heraldic ranks. While all of the positions I am about to mention are heralds, not all of them are Heralds. In Calontir, these ranks are primarily based on the position a herald holds. The heraldic officer for a Shire or Barony is a Pursuivant. The Heraldic officer for the Kingdom is the Principal Herald, and their staff are Heralds. A Shire's herald is typically referred to as <Group name> Pursuivant (Lost Moor Pursuivant). A Barony's Pursuivant will typically bear a unique title registered to the Barony (Anser Pursuivant. Gemshorn Pursuivant). The Kingdom's Principal Herald also has a unique title that is registered to the Kingdom (Gold Falcon Principal Herald. Sanguinaris Principal Herald.). The staff of the Kingdom's Principal Herald also have unique heraldic titles, all of them registered to the Kingdom (Saker Herald. Eyas Herald). When a herald steps down from their position, the heraldic rank remains with the position.

With the granting of the Herald Extraordinary rank, the herald receives the right to their own unique heraldic title. A title registered to them, not the kingdom nor barony, and it remains theirs in perpetuity. I am considering a few options for my own title. Feel free to ask me about Heralds Extraordinary, my heralds title, or virtually any other aspects of heraldry!

Champions

On August 19th, Lonely Tower will hold a dual Champions' Revel, to discover the new Archery and Cut&Thrust champions for the barony. But what are champions? What do they do? How do you become a Champion?

Every group, from Kingdoms down to shires, can have champions. Champions represent their group in competitions, and sometimes escort the Crown or Coronet. Some champions are appointed, some win a competition.

In Calontir, the rattan, archery and Cut & Thrust kingdom level champions are appointed, while the A&S champion wins a competition. (I'm not sure about the equestrian champion, but I think they are appointed.) Other kingdoms do things differently. Not every reign will have a champion in all areas, but it is usual to have a King's Champion, and a Queen's Champion. These are frequently both rattan fighters, appointed by Their Majesties.

Within the Barony, we usually have four Champions, one chosen by competition each season. In the Spring, we have a Cut &Thrust competition to determine the champion. In the Summer, the Archery Champion is chosen. Fall is the time for the Rattan Championship, and Winter is the season for A&S. Sometimes weather or scheduling difficulties will cause the timing of the championships to slip a little, which is why we are now having both the Cut &Thrust and Archery Championships in August. There will be a pot luck and a baronial court in addition to the championship competitions.

Anyone can enter these competitions, keeping in mind the duties and responsibilities. Never enter a competition you are not prepared to win. The duties of the champion are fairly simple. The Champions guard Their Excellencies during court, and represent the barony at as many events and competitions as the champion can manage. The champion is also responsible for running the competition to determine their successor. Usually there is some regalia that the champion can wear to designate them as the champion—a baldric or tabard, a spear or arrows, or a giant needle. The more participants there are, the better the competition, and may the best win!

From the Baronial A & S Champion

Greetings everyone.

Though summer is still fierce upon our heads, preparing for winter cannot come too soon. To that end, I encourage all to prepare for and enter the baronial A&S championship that will take place at the winter revel.

This year's championship will be two entries: one category that you are good at, and one that you have just begun to learn how to do.

Example: Bathilde has been weaving for some time now--she's rather practiced at it and many think her quite good; she has never experimented with historical cooking. Therefore, her entries could be something she has woven, and something she has redacted and cooked.

I hope that we will see many entries and that you enjoy trying out something totally new.
