I'm looking for a Deputy who would like to practice what I'm doing, but you won't be doing Official monthly newsletter & send out. If the person willing to become my Deputy enjoys this position, that person will need to apply for Chronicler position prior to when my time serving is up (which is January 2020). The only thing that Deputy/Chronicler will need to have is the Word Publisher app. The duties of the Chronicler are: to be able to change the cover photo page monthly, to ask others to share their photos or publish online information after getting permission to use, including all information the Officers will send you via e-mail, whatever information and articles received must be copied and pasted, calendar events updated, and to be able to convert Word Publisher files to PDF form in order to send out via both e-mail and snail mail by the end of the month. One hard copy of every monthly newsletter must be printed out baronial records in the BLT file. Both email and snail mail addresses updated as needed. It can be tedious but really takes little time to learn, yet it is a really important yet enjoyable creative experience to create a wonderful Banner newsletter every month! From the Chancellor of the Exchequer

Greetings to the barony from your exchequer.

It has been a quiet month on financial front. Therefore, I would like to discuss budgets.

Every officer has an annual budget that must be submitted before the October business meeting. It is good for the following calendar year. Reason for the date being that first the exchequer and seneschal must look them over to find any legal reasons why they might not be approved—and if it is a newer officer, to perhaps correct their math. Between the 1st and the business meeting, the Finance Committee will view and discuss the budgets virtually. Then, the Finance Committee will meet directly following the October business meeting to discuss and approve/disapprove them. Then, they are sent to Kingdom for final approval no later than 31 October.

An officer's annual budget can be as simple as gas money for CalonCon, or as complex as printing fees for preprints, \$25 compensation for gas/materials for traveling instructors that come to teach us, or the many faceted QuarterMaster budget that covers everything from toilet paper to step-ladders, to dump runs for disposal.

From the Financial Committee

Financial Committee Meeting August 15, 2019

Reimburse seneschal for CalonCon gas. Budget was \$50, receipt was \$55, check 2620 \$50

Reimburse seneschal in lieu of QMaster for dump run and gas. Budget is \$300, receipt was \$61. Check 2621 for \$61

Reimburse baron for loaner gear purchase. Knights Marshal budget is \$300, receipt was \$200, check 2619 for \$200. Purchase was cleared by the KM

Our finances will be in dire circumstances after the first of the year. We have had no revenue, and we will have \$2500 in bills, not including the fees for 12th night.

As a reminder, baronial Officer budgets are due absolutely no later than 1 October. This doesn't mean you won't get money if you need it, it just means that it has to be approved by the FC prior to a) making the purchase, and b) getting the money.

M. Mischa discussed sites for the Warlord Ribbon tourney and his hopes that he would have a bid ready by next business meeting.

Seneschal discussed further cleaning of the storage unit and possible movement to a different unit in the same complex for \$2 more per month (raising our annual fee to \$936.)

Warlord Ribbon Tourney

While I'm still hammering out the details for the tournaments (rattan and C&T), I need to find volunteers to help fill a few roles.

First off, the event was originally penciled in for 19 October. That was a week after Crown Tourney, which is scheduled as a long weekend at Smithville Lake. As that was a bit too close, and the site has a couple of weddings scheduled in October as well, we are moving the event to 2 November. It will be at the Cass County Fairgrounds, and will be a one day event.

Currently, I am planning on opening Gate at 9am, running authorizations from 10am-Noon, having the Lists open 10am to Noon.
