

From the Chatelaine

What is a newcomer? When is a newcomer no longer a newcomer? Neither of these very good questions have definitive answers. The answers are almost entirely subjective. The easy answer is that a newcomer is someone who is new to the SCA, and remains a newcomer as long as they feel unsure of how things work.

Everyone has their own ideas about who is, or isn't, still a newcomer. Their Majesties have said that a newcomer is someone at their first event, and gives them a cup as a gesture of welcome. This does not mean that they are no longer new for having received the cup.

I think of a newcomer as someone who has been in for less than a year, who has no awards, and who does not yet have a registered name or device. This last comes from my beginnings as a herald—there are fighters who would say it is a fighter who is not yet authorized, or who has never won a tournament. (although I know of a few Counts who claim to have only won one tournament!)

Mistress Nesscia and I are beginning a project to welcome newcomers to the Barony. Following the lead of Their Majesties, we are proposing to give the gift of garb to our newcomers in the barony. We are asking for donations of fabric and trim, which we (mostly Mistress Nesscia) will make into simple T-Tunics, and have available at events for newcomers to take, and keep. We will ask that each newcomer only take one tunic, and not build an entire wardrobe from our efforts, and for those of us who are not new, please refrain from supplementing you wardrobe. We are also asking for feastgear—a simple plate and bowl—for new people.

We are funding this effort both with donations of fabric and trim, and also with the sales of books donated for this purpose. At Coronation the book sale raised over \$200!

If you see our rack of tunics at an event, please send newcomers our way, and shop our book sales to help us continue the project.

From the Anser Pursuivant

From the Anser Pursuivant:

SCA people sure love their cats and dogs. In my many years as a herald, I can safely say that the most common charges I ever get asked about are some form of cat' or some form of 'dog.' Their popularity is also what makes them some of the more challenging charges to build a successful submission around.

First, there is their simple popularity. The SCA is more than 50 years old, and a lot of cat and dog lovers have preceded your new submission. Many people have gone down this path before. No matter if the thought is to immortalize a beloved pet, or identify with the curiosity of the house cat, or the loyalty of the dog, many SCA folk have thought of submissions just like this before. With that many arms and devices already registered, it is quite likely that you have been beat to your first idea. Or an idea that is close enough to yours that yours will not go through.

Second, both cats and dogs have an additional challenge. If you look at period heraldry, you will find that it is often tough to determine if that animal on those arms is a dog, or perhaps a wolf. Is that a lynx, a house cat, or perhaps a wildcat on those arms? Its tough to say. And that is why the College grants no difference between different "dogs," nor does it grant difference between different "cats." A dog is a dog is a dog. Wolves, dogs, and even foxes do not receive a difference between one another. A cat, is a cat, is a cat. Lions, lynx and domestic cats, same story, no difference between them.

So, right from the start your idea may be more of a challenge with getting it past already registered arms. This letter is not to say that it is impossible – do not dispair! There are a variety of ways to add difference. Do not be discouraged from an idea that has a wolf or a wildcat! Just be prepared to work with your herald perhaps a bit more to get an idea for your arms that is unique, medieval in style, and most importantly, one that you will like and use in your SCA life!

Event Report

King's Companie of Archers

Earlier in September, the Barony of the Lonely Tower sent eight intrepid archers to shoot for the honor of Their Excellencies Augustin and Aleit, to the glory of the Lonely Tower. They were led by Her Excellency Kezia. Master Rolf, Lord Michael de Lundie, Lady Eden and Roger of Bellebrocton rounded out the team. Baron Augustin and Sir Bjame generously offered to shoot for our neighbor Mag Mor. The Baronial Champion, Master Dolan, still recovering from his recent illness, offered to step aside for the day, as he was unsure of his ability to finish out the day.

The weather was perfect for shooting. The forecast had been for rain, which may have affected attendance, but the rain held off, and the skies were cloudy and the temperatures cool. Their Excellencies provided a day shade for the comfort of the archers, but it was only needed as a resting place, and not as shelter from the heat or storms.

The day began auspiciously when Baron Augustin asked Their Majesties for permission to conduct a bit of business during Court. Lady Eden and Roger were then called forward and inducted into the Baronial order of the Defenders of the Gate! This is the barony's award for the martial arts, and was well deserved by both.

The day's shooting went well, interrupted only by a tasty lunch provided by Mistress Ishmala. At the end of the day, the sun came out, just in time for evening court. Among the winners announced were Master Rolf, who won the huscarl crossbow division, and had the high score for the day, and Roger of Bellebrocton, who tied for top unranked longbow. In spite of that, the Baronial team was only able to manage third, behind the Barony of Forgotten Sea and the Barony of Three Rivers. The Barony of Mag Mor, with the help of Lonely Tower's archers, broke 200 for the first time. (On a personal note, Lady Eden and Sir Bjame were tied for most of the day, with the final shoot being the tie-breaker, which Lady Eden won.)

Following court there was a delicious potluck, and singing around the campfire. The morning dew was heavy, so those who stayed the night have gone home with wet canvas, but the event was one of the best Her Excellency Kezia have attended.
