

From the Chronicler

Cover Photo: Mistress Nesscia Inghean Chearnaigh took a picture of Viking Hogback Stone of Luss, Loch Lomond, Scotland.

According to Lynne's blog <u>https://blosslynspage.wordpress.com/2016/08/19/the-viking-hogback-stone-of-luss-loch-lomond-</u>scotland/:

This is what I could remember seeing many years ago in Luss graveyard, although I had seen it before the stones restoration. Now fully restored, you can see the wonderful markings on this ancient 11th century Viking Hogback Stone. Hogbacks are stone carved Anglo-Scandinavian sculptures from 10th-12th century England. This stone is thought to have dated from the Loch Lomond raid of 1263, when the Vikings had pillaged and settled on the lochside, maybe one Viking that stayed. It was unearthed in 1926 and until very recently had been covered in moss, but now restored. The solid stone blocks are not, as the name might suggest, representations of pigs but stones which are designed to make the tombs of the dead look like mighty buildings in the Norse style. The bow-sided shape of the hogbacks are similar to the classic Viking house and the interlace patterns on them are also very Scandinavian in origin, but this type of stone are only found here in Britain. They are not to be found in Scandinavia and also there're none to be found before the Vikings came here. It could be, as we were great carvers of stone, they saw this and emulated us. Govan in Glasgow has a large number of hogbacks and various other ancient stones, the hogbacks are found exclusively in areas of Northern Britain settled by Vikings, Southern Scotland, Cumbria and Yorkshire.

Chronicler's note: I encourage you to look her blog up and see close up pictures of detailed carving hogback stone.

An Attempt at Garb

When attending a SCA event, an individual must make an "attempt" at Pre-17th Century garb. However, an "attempt" isn't defined. This is because everyone's attempt will be different and unique to them.

An attempt can be a simple tunic and pants. Getting a tunic and pants can be as easy as talking with your local chatelaine and using "Gold Key", which is garb made by the barony for new folks to borrow. There are also many other places garb can be acquired, such as Etsy, Ebay, or really anywhere on the internet. There are SCA Facebook 2nd hand sale pages that frequently have garb, armor, and accessories for sale, as well. However, buying online is sometimes nerve-wracking for folks. So attending events, where you have the opportunity to touch, try on, and see what you are buying are fantastic. In December, Calontir hosts an event called Kris Kinder, which is focused solely on SCA vendors (and shopping!). It's a perfect opportunity to get a new belt, rattan, throwing weapons, or a new outfit.

Another way to gain garb is to make it. The Barony of the Lonely Tower is lucky to have many adept seamstresses and sewers. So, even if you're not confident in patterning and sewing, or don't have a machine, there is usually someone you can talk to about getting help to make garb. Right now we have a sewing circle that meets at libraries around Omaha on Thursday evenings to work on projects. These gatherings are meant to be an opportunity for all to come and learn. It's a chance to work on your personal projects, or help make some "Gold Key" garb.

Ultimately, your garb will be unique to you. It depends on whether you borrow, buy, or make your first set of garb. Talking with members in the barony, and your chatelaine, are the best ways to come up with ideas of what you'd like to wear. Remember that you are starting an awesome journey filled with fun and learning. Welcome!

The easiest way to learn documentation is to fill in a simple form. A pdf that asks you questions and gives you tips for what you're suppose to include. It's a great way to get started.

The form is called EZ-DOC. Once you get to the page there are three to choose from. Click on the one that fits your nifty creation. Then fill it out.

Once you'r done be sure to print out four copies. Three for your competition judges to read and one for your records.

Keeping a copy for yourself is great when a year later a friend asks you how you made your nifty thing. It's also great five years later to see for yourself how much you've improved.
