From the Seneschal

Unto the Populace of the Barony of the Lonely Tower come greetings from your Seneschal.

Let's get right down to business shall we? Yes, 12th Night for January 2020 has been canceled. Was this an easy decision? No it was not, there are a lot of logistics that play into an event happening or not happening. What we DID have working of us: We have an amazing Event Steward that was willing to run the event for the 2nd year, Thank you Master Mikail for stepping up to take on the task, and again I apologize for things not working. We had an event site, one that allows us to use the space we need, and a bit of wiggle room with day of space needed, there was never an issue with the site. What we DID NOT have working for us: Weather, as always winter in Nebraska can be a fickle thing, combine that with the constantly decreasing attendance numbers for events, along with Coronation a week later in the Barony of Forgotten Sea that makes people look a bit closer at event travel during the winter. Also, there was a change in Their Majesties schedules over the Holidays and therefore 12th Night came off of Royal Progression. Combine all of that, the question of the event losing money; or making a slim profit the choice was made to cancel for this year. We can reset; look at the event, how it is run, how we would like it to run, see what is needed and what is not to make it a successful event. At times it is better to cancel than to run an event into a rut and also run through a dwindling pool of individuals who are willing to step up to the plate and run the event.

As I have said before, and will state again, if you would like to run an event, then **step up!** Find a site, check the kingdom calendar and reach out to the Kingdom Reeve, who is now Lady Nadya Helming and she can be reached at: reeve@calontir.org to see if bids have been accepted for upcoming Kingdom events. CC me on those emails! If nobody has a bid in, put one together, get a staff in place, find a site, have them PENCIL us in for the date needed. Put the bid forward at a business meeting. Again, email myself; blt.seneschal@gmail.com, the exchequer, blt.exchequer@gmail.com and Their Excellencies, blt.baronage@gmail.com a copy of the bid, and all information and we can put it forward at a financial committee meeting. And it doesn't have to be a kingdom event, a local event can be run, just double check with the Reeve to see if the weekend is available and then bring the idea to the Business Meeting!

I am going to let everyone know that we will be hosting July 2020 Coronation. We have a site and a Feast Steward secured! What I will be needing between now and Spring 2020 Crown is staff. So if you were sad or upset that 12th Night is canceled, here is a way to make up for it. Volunteer to fill needed spots. There are multiple vacancies that need to be filled, and I am talking more than just sitting at Gate and helping to clean up at the end of the day. What is needed is key individuals. Will we have fighting? Sure, do we have a Marshal for it? Nope. Can we have A&S classes? Ya bet! Do we have anyone to organize it yet? Nada. Talk to me, let's see where we can find a spot that you like. And are you interested but not sure? Then talk to me still. We can see about finding someone who has been there before to mentor you / be a sounding board, or be an assistant.

As most of you have seen we are now at our winter indoor site, Hillside Elementary school at 74th and Western. Times are 7p-9p, on the 1st and 3rd Tuesday till April. We have room for fighting and a small area down the hall and up a few stairs to sit, talk, and be out of the way of the fighters. We can also see about small Arts & Science projects happening, please attend first to see if the space will work and then we can see if anything can happen the next time.

As always, these sites cost, and this year it is not too expensive, but with no events in the near future there is nothing to offset the cost. If you would like to donate towards the cost, please let myself and the Exchequer know. We will work with you on getting your donation done correctly, deposited and all that goes along with it. Just think...for only \$10 / month you too can support a lonely fighter..... Sad music and sad eyed fighter in the background....

Baronial things that need attention: Officers, please check your warrant dates. Some are **DANGEROUSLY CLOSE** to expiring and it is your responsibility to find either a replacement or asking your Kingdom counterpart about an extension.
