

## From the Chatelaine

The Basics of Feast Gear and Where to Find It

When attending SCA events, more often than not there is a feast afterward. Feast is a wonderful opportunity for cooks to show off their new dishes they've learned, and for the populace to experience some delicious foods we normally may not normally eat. There's a catch...You need feast gear!

What is feast gear? This is a usually a plate, bowl, cup, silverware, and some sort of napkin. For your first couple of events you can use what you have from home, or borrow from the Gold Key that is with the Chatelaine. However, many people want their stuff to match their persona, or have a set that is their own. Where can you get dishes that look as if they are medieval? Well, you can shop at events: wars, Kris Kinder, other events that have merchants, you can check out local second hand stores, or a World Market store (they often have dishes and silverware that will pass muster). A mug/cup is one thing in Calontir you will not have to worry about because it is a tradition in our Kingdom that your first Kingdom event you go up during court, and you are gifted a mug. However, people will often have more than one. For example, I have three. If you are wanting to do feast gear on the cheap, scouring local consignment and second hand shops is a great way to find something as well.

### Some recommendations:

Wooden bowls are always a great addition to your feast gear. These were very common throughout many time periods. Also looking at pottery, either thrown or hand formed dishes, as these would have been made regularly. Just make sure that any glaze on the pottery is food grade and safe! Some cultures used glass dishes and cups as well, so keeping an eye out for these pieces is also great. Metal and wooden eating utensils are very common throughout many time periods. However, it depends on your persona if you'd use some utensils. For example, spoons were very common, but eating with forks was not common. Many cultures even today still eat a lot of their food with their hands. This is also why a napkin is important. You can find these for very little cost at many second hand stores, or you can make your own with extra linen or fabric left over from making garb. What you decide to purchase, make, and where you decide to get it is entirely up to you. As with garb, you can be as creative as you like in this endeavor. It all depends on how you want your feast gear to look, and how much you want to spend. It will require some research, and maybe talking with your friends. Make sure to check museum websites for artifacts because food utensils are surprisingly common finds in the archaeological record, as they were made to last! If you have any questions, or need Gold Key feast gear, though make sure to talk with your Chatelaine!

## From the Financial Committee

28 August 2019 1150 Virtual meeting notes.

Good afternoon to the Finance Committee.

Here opens the virtual meeting:

We have been offered the opportunity to move our storage unit out of the depths of the back, closer to the front of the property...but it comes at a price, and that price is two-fold.

First: There are two available units for \$92.99 (\$1,116 annual), one is a large door in the first row with known water issues (floods under the door and would require us to keep everything up) and one is in the second row with two doors. The third is \$105.99 (\$1,272 annual) and is a large door in the front row, close to the gate.

Second: We have to pay the monthly fee on both units for one month. There is no pro-ration done--even if we move on the 31st and the 1st, unless we hold all the stuff in the vehicles for a day, we still have to pay for the other unit.

Pros: easier access for loading and unloading

possibility of no more (or less) water damage since the unit would be uphill

Cons: money. it costs more not just to move, but the new unit monthly price. Our current bill is just under \$1k.

we need to organize about 6 able-bodied ppl (more might be just too many) to move everything and possibly rebuild the shelves

September would be a good moving time for temps. We don't have any events planned--no bids in yet for 12th night even. Please discuss by responding to this email.

I will ask for a vote on Friday.

I think the large door may be beneficial, however not sure if 200/yr is worth avoiding the potential water damage if we are going to have everything on shelves anyway. I'm not sure that the bigger door with potential water damage is worth the same as the 2 doors we've been living with.
