

## 1st Quarter Archery Scores

The final results of the Quarterly and Saltire Shoot are in. This was the Winter Society Seasonal Challenge. Archers from Lonely Tower competed against the archers from across the Knowne World who participated in this shoot.

Of the 191 archers who participated, Master Dolan finished 24th with a Period Crossbow score of 55, and tied for 25th with an Open Crossbow score of 54.

Lord Owain the Younger tied for 59th with an Open Handbow score of 40, and Lord Gaius tied for 81st with an Open Handbow score of 33.

Lady Jorunna finished in a tie for 92nd with her open Handbow score of 30, and M'Lady Makayla, who was not able to complete the shoot, tied for 185th with a score of 4.

Only two of Lonely Tower's archers were able to complete the Gwyntarian Winter Challenge before the shutdown. While more scores may come in before the shoot officially ends April 15th, these are probably close to the final standings.

Of the 114 archers throughout the Knowne World who completed this shoot, Master Dolan came in 10th overall (2nd of six crossbows) with a score of 156. Lord Owain the Younger came in tied for 61st (16th of 28 Longbows). They were only able to do this shoot once.
