

# **Exchequer Checking-In**

Greeting from the Exchequer!

As a reminder—I am in search of a replacement come January. Letters of Intent should be sent to the Senschal and the Baronage (and me if you like) prior to 10 August. There will be interviews of all candidates and a decision will be made.

Notes from CalonCon 2020:

Reminder: All officers are required to meet with the Kingdom Officer at least once per year. CalonCon fulfills this requirement—if you miss it, you must make arrangements with Kingdom to meet at another time/place.

There are open Kingdom positions: Exchequer Regional Deputies, NMR deputy, and Nebraska Tax Deputy. Please see the Kingdom page for more information and to apply.

Book Reviews: Must be done every 2-years and when a new exchequer takes office. BLT is overdue, but it will be delayed until the new officer takes the seat in January at the behest of Kingdom.

Warrants: Only the primary is warranted. Deputies are on file but not warranted unless needed. If the primary exchequer is going to be out of the area for longer than a few weeks, Kingdom must be notified and the deputy warranted.

Bank Account Requests: New form from Society May 2020 version 6. Use this one. Kingdom must be on the account; if there is a spot for a Beneficiary, it should be Kingdom. To get Kingdom's signature, secure email should be used.

Financial Policies: Society has published a new policy and format. It is posted on the Exchequer Google Drive—when doing your reviews this October, use this format. Remember, Kingdom must have it for review/approval by December.

Training: Thus far training for the position has not been formalized or documented. All exchequers (and deputies) need to reread the handbook and then report to Kingdom once finished. If there are any questions at all, Kingdom is happy to answer and will offer additional training as requested. Please ask for training. There is a training book coming—one for experienced exchequers and one for brand new ones. Hoping to be completed by the end of the year. In the mean time, please ask.

This isn't a hard job but it is detail oriented. Rumour has it that it is easy to get into trouble and banished/fined/jailed by taking this position. No and Yes...money laundering and borrowing from the account is bad—but that's about it. Honest mistakes are understandable and can be corrected.

Ledgers: they will be standardized. There is a new form on the Society webpage, use it. (I will be moving 2020 over to this over the next few weeks and the new form will be submitted with our Q2 report).

Use the LOCKED forms from Society to ensure you have the most updated one.

Storage fees go under Tab Income\_4 on your report.

Monthly reconciliation forms and Quarterly reports must always be signed by the Seneschal. It can be done via email—put it into a file, print it, or attach it somehow.

Q4 (the Domesday) must be physically signed, scanned, and filed both electronic and paper once approved by Society and Kingdom.

There can be no monies being handled at the Gate table but event fees—and feast can be considered part of the event fee. All donations etc. must be at an entirely different table.

The outdoor range is at 9100 Pawnee Road.


New Baronial A&S Minister Needed.

# Garden Grotto & Cooking with Cristina



### Cormarye

This month's recipe redaction is not mine; it comes from Kainan. Many of our Barony may have had occasion to enjoy this roast pork at a feast a few years ago. I sampled it not long ago during a brief—and distant—visit and was enraptured. Delicious. Recommendation from the cook is to double the mushrooms and leeks just because they are so good with it.

Source [Forme of Cury, S. Pegge (ed.)]: Cormarye. XX.II. XIII. Take Colyandre, Caraway smale grounden, Powdour of Peper and garlec ygrounde in rede wyne, medle alle bise togyder and salt it, take loynes of Pork rawe and fle of the skyn, and pryk it wel with a knyf and lay it in the sawse, roost berof what bou wilt, & kepe bat bat fallith berfro in the rosting and seeb it in a possynet with faire broth, & serue it forth with be roost anoon.

Pork Tenderloin with Mushrooms and Leeks

1 pork tenderloin

Spice mix: 1 Tbl each cracked whole coriander, cracked caraway seeds, cracked black pepper, garlic powder, and salt.

8 oz red wine

2 cups each sliced mushrooms and leeks

1 cup chicken or vegetable stock

The night before: rinse and dry the tenderloin, prick it all over with a fork, rub well with the spice blend and put into a ziplock bag. Add the wine and place into the refridgerator for 12-24 hours, turning it over once [this ensures both sides get fully submerged].

When ready to cook, remove pork from the fridge and bring to room temperature. Preheat the oven to 450 degrees.

[SAVE THE MARINADE WHEN YOU REMOVE THE PORK]

Heat 2 Tbl olive oil in a cast iron or heavy steel skillet over high heat [needs to be oven safe to 450]; sear the tenderloin on all sides—takes about 10 minutes total.

Turn off the heat; leave the meat in the pan and add the marinade, mushrooms, leeks, and stock [yes, it is safe to add the marinade. It is going to boil at high temps for longer than 10 minutes, so anything that may be in it will be dead]. Place the pan in the oven for 20 minutes or until a meat thermometer stuck into the thickest part reaches 137 degrees.

Remove from oven and set the meat aside; put the pan back on the stove and bring it to a hard boil. Boil until it reaches desired thickness [it won't ever get syrupy thick, but it will reduce a bit—about half is nice].

Slice meat and serve with sauce and vegetables.

[my notes: this can be a rather intensely flavoured dish. If pepper is spicy for you (no judgement here!), reduce it to 1 tsp in the initial rub, or substitute it with up to the full Tbl of cracked grains of paradise. I don't always have leeks lying around, so onions sliced thick could be substituted, but the finished product doesn't look as nice or have the same mouth-feel. As this is such a fiery dish, a vinegar-based salate, sweet roasted carrots, and soft white bread (possibly with a thyme butter) would be grand accompaniments. I haven't tried this with anything but pork yet, but have a venison loin in the cold box that is earmarked—I will keep you informed]

Allium cepa proliferum, previously classified as Allium cepa vivifarum (among other things) is now believed to be a cross of an (Allium cepa) the cultivated onion, and a (Allium fistulosum) Welsh onion. This interesting onion has been known in the US since the 18<sup>th</sup> century, imported from Europe, and is believed to have originated in India. Commonly called Egyptian Walking Onion...not really sure why unless they are alluding to the Egyptian love of onions.


As the onion matures, the bulbils at the top get rather large and the main stem weakens, thus toppling the mother plant—no seeds, just the bulbils. As it topples over, the bulbils are brought into contact with the ground. If the conditions are right, they will root, sprout, and begin anew. Thus their name of "walking"...they will move down a hedgerow in short order if allowed.



A perennial, these fabulous beasties like full sun and damp but well-drained soil—just like their brethren the other Alliums. Give them space—at least 6 inches between plantings. They will bunch and multiply at the base; giving them room lets them do this and gives you room to get in there and harvest a few without lifting the entire colony.







These will grow fine in a container or in the ground. Hardy to zone 3; they are the first things up in spring in my zone 5 garden... even before the mint.

Harvest the small green shoots for green onions—they are very sweet. To pull the entire onion—grab at the base firmly and gently twist and rock back and forth as you lift slowly. If you yank, you'll lose the whole thing. These can be used as you would any onion. I have heard tell that they are more pungent than the common onions, but have not found that to be the case with mine—perhaps I keep mine too well watered for that to occur.

The bulbils can be used fresh in the fall (peel them), frozen for soup, or even pickled. The older, larger, green stalks are rather flavourless and woody—I do not recommend them; use the white parts though, they are good and spicy.

If this plant interests you, please contact me and I will obtain bulbils for you to plant.
