

The Plague Times...Episode 5: Prepping for "War"

While everything is cancelled until January 31, 2021, many folks are diligently planning for wars and events next year. So, you've had an opportunity to get your garb sewn, but what other things do you need for an event, especially a multi-day event? The first things you need to consider: when is the event (will it be hot, cold, or possibly both)?, where is the event (can you drive in 1 day, or will you need to stay overnight somewhere along the way)? How long are you going for? What will you be participating in at this event (fighting, archery, arts and sciences, bardic, etc) These are some of the first questions you'll want to figure out. These answers are central to some of the things you need to pack to take with you. This will help you determine if you need heavy or light garb for the day and night, or a mix of both. Depending on where the event is taking place, and if it's really far away tells you if you need to plan for a stop along the way, or if you can easily make it in one day. This is important, especially if you need to request time off of work. How long will you be at the event, determines how much garb and supplies you need to bring with you. What you participate in helps to determine what specific items you need to bring with you, that you cannot leave behind.

Here is an example list of things to bring with you:

Garb and mundane clothing are also necessities, but those will be specific to what you have in your closet and your persona. Make sure to plan to have enough for your trip, or bring laundry detergent if you need to hit up a laundromat. This list does mention snacks, but also take into account if you'll be cooking every day at the event, only cooking 1 meal a day, or if you're subsisting on the food court/inn available. You can also travel off site for food. However, if you're cooking you'll need to plan your kitchen and all the things you need to bring to cook at a campsite. Most larger events, like wars, do have a food court you can eat at. They also typically have a merchant area as well. So, if you don't have something you may be able to purchase it, but don't rely on that. Try to be as prepared as possible for the event. Also talk with your friends who are also planning to go to the event, if they have been before they can offer you some excellent advice about what to expect. Never be afraid to ask questions!


