




#### **Chatelaine Chat**

The Plague Times...Episode 8: What Do Officers Do?

One of the top ways to support your local barony, is to volunteer! There are many ways you can volunteer your time to ensure that the barony thrives. One way is becoming an officer. There are many officer positions available in the Barony of the Lonely Tower. The following are volunteer officer positions you can hold in the barony:

Seneschal, exchequer, chronicler, web-minister, herald (Anser Pursuivant), chatelaine/e, social media officer, arts and science minister, marshal (of a variety of armed activities, armored combat, archery, cut and thrust, youth combat, equestrian, etc.), and quartermaster. Each of these positions has one aspect for our barony that they are in charge of.

The seneschal is the president for the group, and their name goes on all the important documents. It's a big job, but you have the support of the rest of the barony and other officers! They are the lead for the business meetings, and they work to make things run smoothly. This office is required in order to maintain our barony status.

Exchequer is the person in charge of the money. They handle the barony finances and make sure we have sufficient funds to operate. They have the check book and they are in charge of the bank account for the barony. Other officers and anyone planning an event must submit their budgets to them for approval. This office is required to maintain barony status.

Chronicler is the person who writes the monthly newsletter and distributes it. They are responsible for getting content from other officers and local members to publish in the newsletter. There are many rules and requirements of things that must be published at certain times of the year and in each newsletter. This is an important office to ensure that our barony members who do not have computer access maintain up to date on the barony happenings. If you like to write and be creative, then this position is for you!

Web-minister is the person responsible for the barony website. They need some basic programming skills, or an interest in learning how to build and maintain a website. If you're interested in IT and Technology this is a great position to volunteer for. This job is a required position to maintain our barony status.

Anser Pursuivant or Herald is someone who helps folks create heraldry, names, badges, and acts sometimes as a voice herald for events and meetings. They do a lot of research to help people get their names and devices passed through the kingdom and known world heraldry to become registered.

Chatelaine/e is the newcomer greeter for the group. Their job is to recruit and help direct new people in the barony. This job requires someone who is a little bit social and willing to regularly check messages and email. It's a very important role, as it helps to foster the barony's growth.

Social Media Officer is the person who creates Facebook event pages, and has control of the barony's social media presence. They partner with other officers to generate social media content to publish on twitter, Instagram, Facebook, and sometimes YouTube. This position requires someone with working knowledge of social media platforms.

Arts and sciences minister is responsible for promoting various arts and sciences within the barony. This means helping to organize classes, teaching classes, and sharing about events that are related to arts and sciences within the SCA.

Marshals are folks who are authorized by the Kingdom of Calontir to monitor, judge, and run combat and other marshalled activities, such as: youth combat, archery, cut and thrust, equestrian, armored combat, thrown weapons, etc. These individuals had to go through training and be approved by the kingdom marshal to run their respective activities. It can take a while to get your marshal in any activity. Talk with your local marshals about the process and what you need to do, if you're interested in becoming a marshal.

Quartermaster is the person in charge of the barony's storage unit and all the stuff in it. They make sure that things are put away properly, and periodically clean out the unit of things that are no longer needed, broken, or no longer useful.

These are just some of the ways you can donate your time and energy to ensuring that the barony runs smoothly. If you're interested in volunteering for a position, reach out to the officers on our barony page, or on facebook to find out how you can get involved. These jobs are all integral to keeping this crazy adventure known as the SCA alive. So do your part, and volunteer today!
