

Sage Words from the Seneschal

To the people of The Barony of The Lonely Tower
Greetings.
As time moves on things around the current pox seem to be improving, this is good news for all and I do hope that it continues. I am sure all of this will be behind us one day, but for that to happen we must all continue to take care of not only ourselves, but also of those around us. We all need to remember that our individual impact travels much further than the reach of our own hands.
One sign that things are returning to normal is the re-start of fighting within the Kingdom. This is a good thing indeed, but, as always, there are rules. The most impactful of these rules are
Masks must be worn over both the nose and mouth of all, even during fighting.
There is no sharing of water jugs. You can "leave out" bottled water but it would be best if fighters just bring there own water / drinks.
All fighting must be Outside, and social distancing should be maintained by all those that are not actively fighting.
No sharing of loner armor.
On November 15th, any fighter that has not fought twice (2 events, or 2 practices, or 1 of each) will be put on In-active status. Drills/slow work doesn't count toward this.
If there are any questions about all of this, please contact myself or Sir Michael and we can sort it all out.
Moving on to other things. After much discussion, it was decided that the July 2021 event here in the Barony will be canceled and the date freed up for use by others. This event was to be coronation but due to the events of the past year, this was not going to happen. We could have still held an event in the place of coronation but the cost of the site made this a less then desirable option. I apologize to any who disagree with this or that it may inconvenience, but I felt it to be the correct choice for the Barony.
The cancellation of one event brings around another subject, and that is of other events. Currently the Barony has two events on the calendar, Masters of the Duel and Winter Coronation. The Masters of the Duel event will be held on September 25 th and focuses on rapier and cut and thrust combat. It is my understanding that there will be many classes and much to learn. Winter Coronation is scheduled for January, keep an eye out for any other information.
Speaking of events, Calon Con is June 26 th and will once more be held online. If you are an officer, please keep your eyes open for any information regarding this. For most officers this is a short set of meetings intended to get you up to speed with current changes and I hope the online format makes it easy for all to attend.
One last thing this time. We are always on the lookout for people to run events. If running an event is something you would like to do, come and talk with me.
As always, if there are any questions, feel free to contact me and I will try to get them answered.

-Greetings to the SCA:

In April of this year, the Board of Directors of the SCA, Inc. issued a proclamation allowing in-person events to resume in North America as of June 1, 2021, subject to any federal, state, provincial, or local government health restrictions, and subject to restrictions imposed by the Board to try to ensure the safety of our participants, given conditions of the pandemic at the time. It was stated then that these restrictions would be revisited as appropriate.

At their May 25, 2021 conference call meeting, the Board of Directors of the SCA, Inc. discussed the latest guidance from the CDC, as well as current trends in the United States in particular with regard to the increasing availability of COVID vaccinations and the decreasing incidence of illness and hospitalizations in the United States. The Board then decided to loosen many of the SCA-imposed restrictions effective July 1, 2021.

The attached proclamation spells out the requirements for in-person events going forward from that July 1 date.

The Board further took the following action:

Motion by Dale Fong-Frederick to approve the following language, and require that it appear on all event notices, flyers, online announcements, and advertisements, as well as being posted in multiple locations, including Troll [Registration], at all events:

Although the SCA complies with all applicable laws to try to ensure the health and safety of our event participants, we cannot eliminate the risk of exposure to infectious diseases during in-person events. By participating in the in-person events of the SCA, you acknowledge and accept the potential risks. You agree to take any additional steps to protect your own health and safety and those under your control as you believe to be necessary.

Seconded by Gigi Coulson. Opposed: None. Motion carried.

This language will be required to appear on all event notices, flyers, online announcements, and advertisements, as well as being posted in multiple locations at any and all SCA-sponsored functions going forward.

A few important notes:

During the month of June, all current restrictions including mask requirements and the 150-person attendance limit remain in effect.

The new proclamation does not take effect until July 1.

As always, any and all federal, state, provincial, and local health rules and restrictions must be followed. If your local government does not allow gatherings above a certain size, or requires masks, those restrictions of course must be enforced.

Individual kingdoms are always allowed to impose more restrictions than those imposed by the SCA, Inc. No kingdom is required to begin holding in-person events if the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal do not believe it is safe yet; a kingdom may continue to require face coverings, impose size limits on events, or prohibit overnight camping if it wishes. The President, Society Seneschal, and Board will support kingdoms in resuming events in the way that seems safest for them.
