

To the people of The Barony of The Lonely Tower

Greetings.

I would like to start by announcing that we have found a replacement for Eadaoin for the office of Arts and Sciences. I would like to thank Eadaoin for her service and welcome Lady Tonika. She is pretty new to the group but is already stepping in. I know everyone will do what they can to welcome and help her.

On a similar note, Jorunna wishes to step aside as the chatelaine and social media director after three years of serving the Barony. If you are interested in this office, please let me or Jorunna know.

The Barony's next event is the Grand Tourney, starting on the Friday 22nd of July and running until 24th of July. This will be a wonderful event and I do hope to see you all there taking part in the fun. They are still in need of a few people to help with both set up and take down, if you have time to help with these efforts, please let Jorunna know.

After the Grand Tourny will need to take a breath and then start to gear up for Coronation which will be held on October 8th at the Relevant Center on 204th and Maple. Ann is working hard to make sure it is an amazing event, expect per-registration to start soon after Pennsic.

I am now going to take a bit of space to repeat the new Covid Rules for the Kingdom as given to me by the Kingdom Seneschal.

"Current Rules for Calontir Event Attendance (effective June 13, 2022)

- 1. COVIDSafe The COVIDSafe policy is separate from these guidelines, and will remain in place until the criteria for suspension have been satisfied. More information on the COVIDSafe policy can be found at https://www.calontir.org/covidsafe/.
- 2. Masks
 - Masks are not required outdoors.
 - While indoor masking is generally encouraged, those individuals who meet the CDC definition of "Fully Vaccinated" may choose not to wear a mask indoors.
 - All those who do not meet the CDC definition of "Fully Vaccinated" must wear masks covering the nose and mouth while indoors, save those under 24 months of age.
- 3. Food
- There are no restrictions on food at this time.
- 4. Drink
- The only restriction at this time is the current Society prohibition on the use of shared drinking vessels for water bearing."

Requests from the Crown:

- 1. If you are medically able to get the COVID Vaccine, please do so. If you are due for a booster, please get one.
- 2. Please do not attend gatherings if you are not feeling well. If someone in your household is Covid positive, or symptomatic, please stay home.
- 3. Please respect the comfort levels of those who wish to follow more stringent masking and distancing practices than are strictly required.
- 4. The SCA is an organization of chivalry and community. Please remember these values and help us all set a good example for the rest of the Known World."
